Early Years Foundation Stage - Nursery and Reception

Autumn 1

This half term our topic was **Once upon a story**

We all learnt about the story of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears.

- Together can your child re-tell the story using any toys you have in your home?
- As you share breakfast together, maybe make porridge or talk about what you are eating.
- Look in your home and talk about what is large, medium and small.
- Make collections of 3 objects.
- Practise writing the number 3.



During half term holidays in order to prepare for next half term's learning:

Homes and Buildings

- When you are in your home together talk about the furniture in each room.
- Play 'I spy' together to learn the names of different objects E.g. "I spy with my little eye something beginning with c" – maybe it was carpet, cooker, cup?
- Also try "I spy with my little eye something to lay my head on" – pillow?
- We will be learning from the story of The Little Pigs – can you tell it together at home?
- Can you draw together every day – support your child in how they hold the pencil.

Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3

Year 1

Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

Year 4



This term Year 4 have been learning about writing a narrative based on Ancient Egypt, Place Value in Mathematics and America's in History. Some highlights for this term include, pupils taking a great interest in this year's Big Draw theme on 'Climate of change'. Pupils showed their most creative side to innovate their own projects and discuss ideas on how they can help preserve the climate. Children have also learnt about electrical safety at home and school and were able to build their own electrical circuits. Next term, we will be learning more about Ancient Egypt and will be writing a newspaper article. During the half term please encourage your child to learn all of their times tables and division facts.

Year 5

In English, we have been reading the Beowulf. In Maths, we have covered place value. For Big Draw, we researched the environmental impact on coral reefs. Next term, we will be continuing to read about legends. You can read the legend of King Arthur or any other legends with your child to help them get a head start. In Maths, we will be covering the written method for multiplication and division.



Half term project: we would like children to research the Staffordshire Hoard by looking at their website: <https://www.staffordshirehoard.org.uk/> They would then need to create their own model of the hoard. It could be a poster, drawing or 3D project.



Year 6

In Year 6, children have written their own diary entries based on the text Aladdin and have started work on a letter linked to the Greeks that we will be studying. In Maths we have learnt addition and subtraction and the written method for multiplication and division. The Big Draw, an art day, was a success with all children producing artwork linked to the theme of 'Climate Change.'

During the half- term children have a project to complete based on the Greeks – there are various creative tasks that the children have been given. Parents can also support us by helping children to learn their times tables and ensuring children complete their home-learning.
