They will have a specialist 'Art TA' when teaching the subject. The successful candidate can negotiate a TLR and be part of the school's curriculum leadership team.

**Part-time** - will involve teaching *art & design* five afternoons (0.5 FTE) - not negotiable.

**Full-time** - applicants will teach *art & design* in the afternoons and provide PPA cover in the mornings. Some of the mornings can be negotiable.
