# Pen portraits of governors

## **Barbara Patilla** – *Co-opted Governor; Chair of the Governing Body*

Barbara has worked in Tower Hamlets since 1980 as a secondary Science and Biology teacher. She first taught in Central Foundation School, then she became an Advisory Teacher in the ILEA (inner London education authority) doing work in both Primary and Secondary schools before joining Mulberry School as a Head of Year. She retired in August 2008. She contributes to a number of local educational projects.

## **David Marks** – *Co-opted Governor, Vice Chair of the Governing Body*

David is a skilled strategy, data and policy analyst professional with more than 10 years' experience in the Higher Education sector having worked across three universities from different mission groups. He has a strong passion to contribute to the education of children in the local community in which he lives.

## **Dennis Twomey** – *Local Authority Governor, Chair of Resources Committee*

Dennis has been involved with the school since the beginning. He has had various responsibilities within the governing body and is currently the Chair. He is involved with a number of projects helping to empower individuals so that they can contribute positively to their community. He is a former leader of the local authority, and has extensive experience of being involved in the public and third sector organisations.

## **Helen Harvey** – *Co-opted Governor*

Helen lives in East London and works as a consultant, supporting businesses in M&A (mergers and acquisitions). In her spare time, she enjoys exploring London and its' many offerings. She keeps active by walking and running along the canal near where she lives, as well as a little yoga. Helen supports the school with her expertise in HR (human resources).

## **Jacqueline Kirsh** – *Co-opted Governor, Chair of Teaching and Learning Committee*

Jacqueline has been in education for over 30 years and the last 18 years as an Executive Headteacher in Hackney where she was born. She is passionate about education and has moved schools to outstanding. She was a finalist in the National Headteacher Awards and received a Lifetime Achievement Award from Hackney 2012.

She has now retired and wants to contribute as a governor to Bigland Green. She has a particular interest in reading, music, history and history of art.

## **Raja Miah** – *Associate Governor*

Raja Miah works in a local school as an IT technician. He has particular skills in relation to computing in primary schools and how new technologies can enhance children's learning experiences. He has supported the school with improving the IT infrastructure before being co-opted to the governing body as he lived locally. In June 2018 he became a parent governor of the school.

## **Umme Aysha** – *Parent Governor*
