The successful candidate will be deployed in a Year group in KS2 or EYFS. They will receive regular school-based training and also have the opportunity to attend other training.

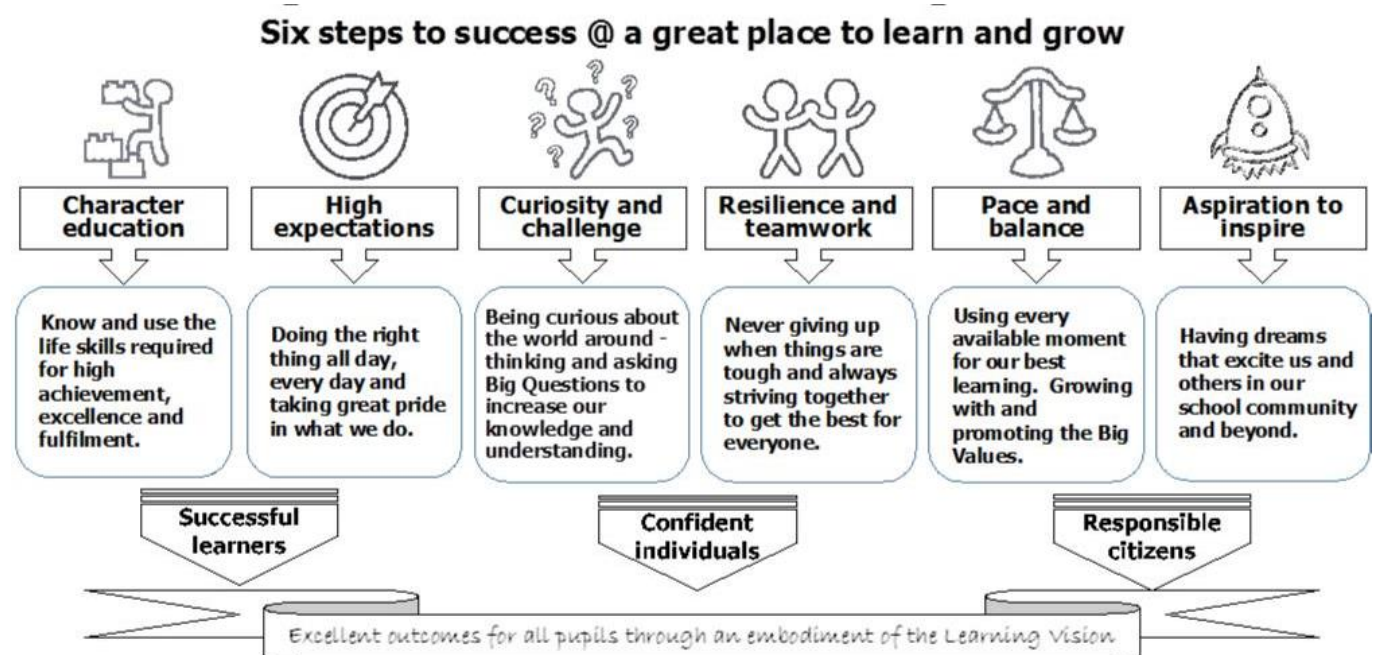
