CORONAVIRUS IN THE FAMILY?

If there is a positive case of coronavirus in your household or family, then kindly inform the school office immediately via phone or email. Children who are not positive can still attend school.

All children aged between 5 and 18 years who have been in contact of someone with COVID-19 are strongly advised to take an LFD test every day for 7 days and continue to go to school unless the child tests positive. Please do a LFD home test on your child, preferably 1-2 hours before school and submit the results to NHS through the link below.

You will receive a confirmation on your mobile phone which you can show at the school reception before your child is taken into class.

To stay safe:

- Get vaccinated
- Wash hands regularly
- Open windows, have ventilation
- Wear a face covering in crowded settings
- If you show symptoms, stay at home and do an LFD test:

If you do test positive, you are required to isolate for 7 days unless you get a negative test result on day 5 and day 6. Please follow government guidance available at
