IS YOUR CHILD ENTITLED TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

If you are in receipt of certain benefits, your child may be entitled to free school meals. You can use the eligibility checker <https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/> to check your entitlement.

The government has made free school meals available to families who are not otherwise entitled to any benefits i.e. parents on work visas, student visas or parents who have no immigration status. These families are identified as families with no recourse to public funds (NRPF). If you feel your child may be entitled to free school meals, please contact Nazma or Amina in the school office who will be able to answer any questions you may have and help you apply.
