## LEAVE DURING TERM TIME

This is a reminder that Bigland Green does not authorise leave during term time. Parents who take leave during term time risk:

- Leave being recorded as 'unauthorised'.
- Receiving a fixed penalty notice issued to both parents (even if they live apart).
- Losing their child's place at Bigland Green. Bigland Green is an officially oversubscribed school with some Year groups having a waiting list of more than 20 pupils.
