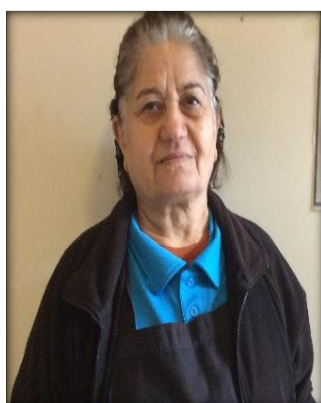


UPCOMING PARENT WORKSHOP
