## PERSISTENT ABSENCE

A pupil with attendance below 90% is classed as persistently absent, even if the absence has been authorised. What does this mean for your child?

- **90% attendance** = half school day missed every week!
- **One school year at 90% attendance** = 4 weeks of learning missed!
- **Over 5 school years at 90% attendance** = Half school year missed!
