Ayaan(Bluebell)- "the trip was so amazing we got to explore the rocket ship and find words to save the planet Nan".

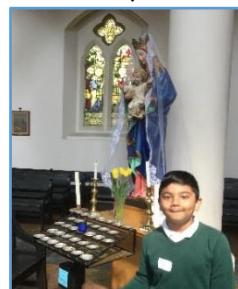


## YEAR 3 TRIP TO ST. MARYS CHURCH
