- Please see school office in advance if you live more than 10 minutes walking distance from the school.


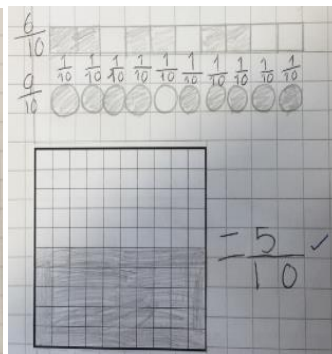
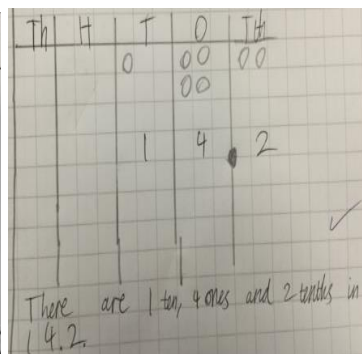
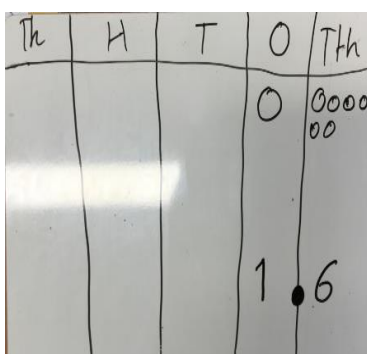
