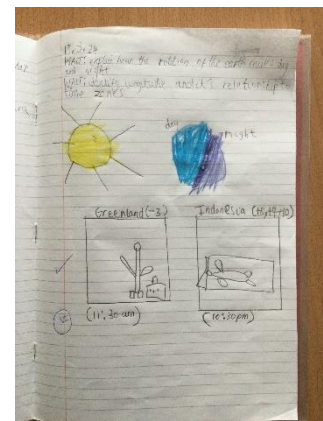
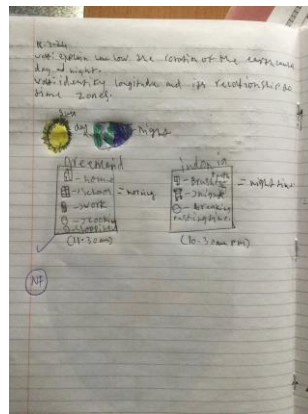
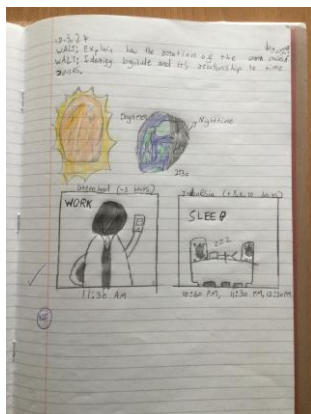


THIS WEEK'S LEARNING IN TULIP

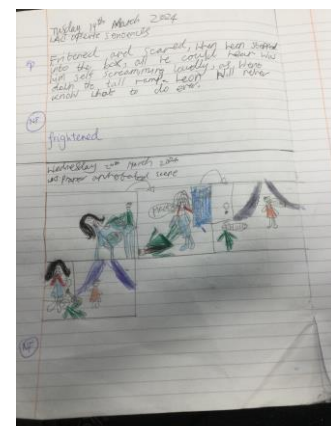
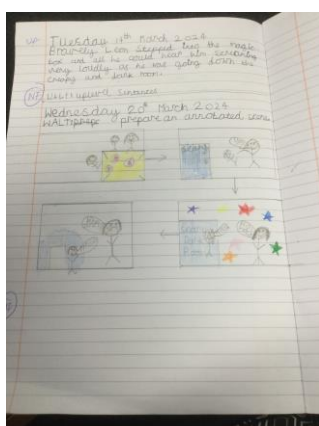
In **PE** this term, children have been learning how to strike and field in Cricket. This week children learnt how to strike the ball in order to score runs. They needed to understand how to aim for the correct spaces in order achieve the correct technique. They have been practicing many skills such as how to field the ball and how to strike the ball from the cone to get it through the target.



In **Geography** this week children learnt about how the rotation of the Earth causes day and night. They also identified what longitude is and its relationship to time zones. Children drew a diagram to represent the Earth's day and night rotation and also drew an image to represent what people would be ideally doing in Indonesia and Greenland at different times to the Prime Meridian longitude (in the UK).



In **English**, children have been rewriting a section of the narrative 'Leon and the Place in Between' creating their own fantasy world and problem for the main character. Children drew their climax/problem section in a few steps to show the problem building up for the character in order to enrich their writing the following day.



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
