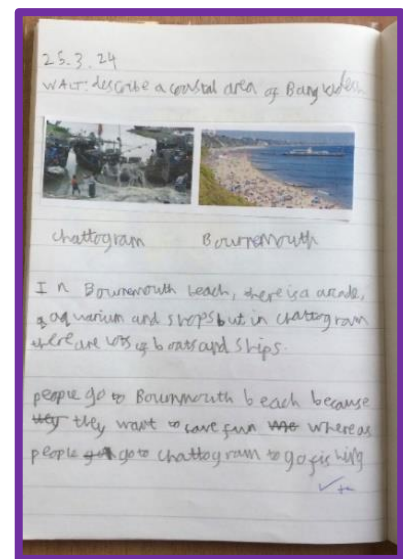
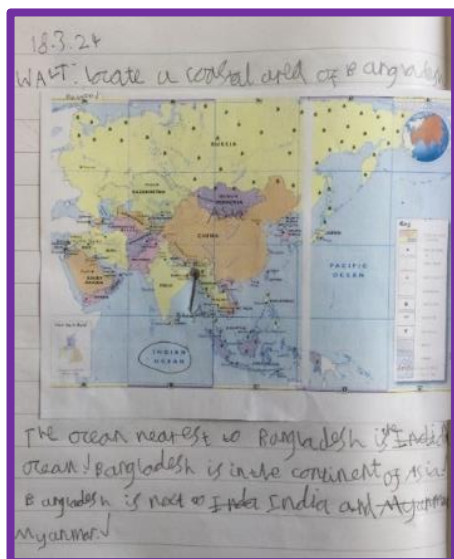


THIS WEEK'S LEARNING IN ROSE CLASS

They have explored different types of coasts and located a coastal area in the United Kingdom (Bournemouth) and in Bangladesh (Chattogram).











They looked at the human and physical features of the two locations and compared it.
