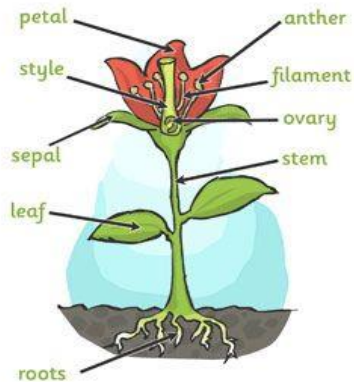


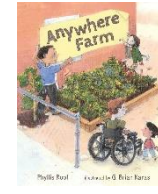
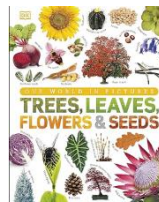
## Key Vocabulary: Plants and Flowers
