



English: Narrative (Mystery)

Children will be writing a section a mystery story which includes many events that take place. They will also write a non-chronological report about a fantasy animal.

Activities at home: Research favourite animal.

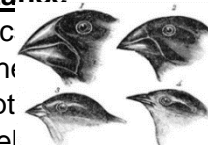
Mathematics: Statistics, Geometry and Measurement

Children will look at properties of shapes, position and directions. The use of coordinates, graphs and the information they show.

Activities at home: How many different shapes can you spot at home? Make a list.

Science: Evolution and Inheritance

Children will look at characteristic passed from one generation to the next and how species have adapt to suit their environments. As well as fossils and what they show us about adaptations.



Activities at home: Create or draw fossils

Physical Education: Invasion game (Tag Rugby)

Children will work collaboratively in teams to understand the rules of tag rugby and participate in games.

Activities at home: Research the rules of tag rugby

Art and Design: Playgrounds

Children will work collaboratively to design and make their own playgrounds.

Activities at home: Visit a playground or adventure park to gather ideas and inspiration.

History: Ancient Greece

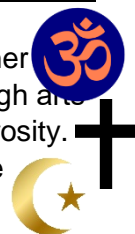
Children will work towards answering the question: Why do historians think Ancient Greece was such a significant civilisation?

Religious Education: Christianity and Islam and Hinduism

Children will explore and discuss whether it's better to express your religion through art and architecture or in charity and generosity.

Activities at home: Compare the three religions. Can you find similarities?



Computing: Quick Show Host

Children will learn how to use an online tool to create a quiz after researching a subject and coming up with questions to ask another group.

Activities at home: Start researching a topic you are interested in already.

Music: Roots

Children will put together a mini musical performance about the effects of slave trade on a West African village.



Activities at home: listen to traditional Ghanaian instrumentals.

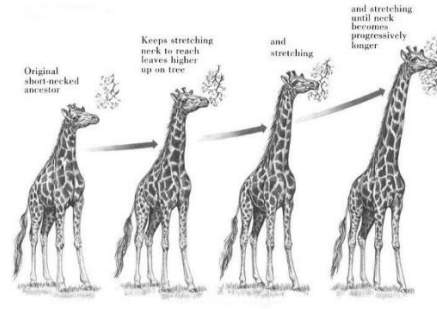
Sketch!
