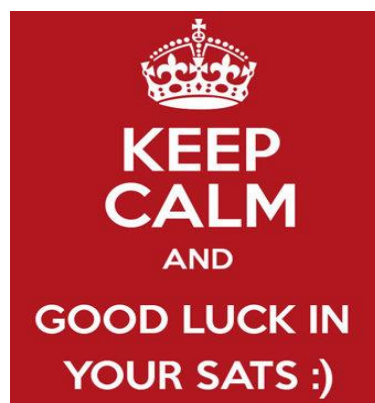
Parents are requested to check the newsletter over the weekend and inform their children if they are *Star of the Week*. The 'Stars' will be celebrated in Mondays school assembly.

FIXED PENALTY NOTICES FOR UNAUTHORISED ABSENCES

Parents will know that Bigland Green has a policy of no authorised holidays during term time. The school is obliged to follow the DfE (Department for Education) guidelines and refer unauthorised absences to the LA for fixed penalty notices.

The DfE has updated its guidance for the issuing of Penalty Notices. As a result, Tower Hamlets has updated its protocol. This new updated protocol will be implemented on Monday 19 August 2024 as required by the DfE.

There are some key changes. One of the changes is that fixed penalty notices will now be £80 for each parent (whether together or not) for each child. There are other requirements on parents including ensuring that their children are not late for school. As before, fixed penalty notices can be issues for lateness as well as unauthorised absences.

This is a reminder that any absences must be reported to the school office. This can be done via our absence line, ParentHub or reported in person at the school office. If parents do not provide the school with a reason, the absence will remain unauthorised.

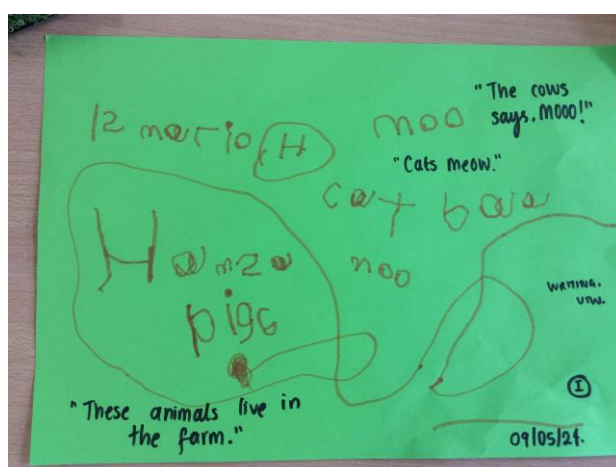
THIS WEEKS LEARNING IN SUNFLOWER CLASS
