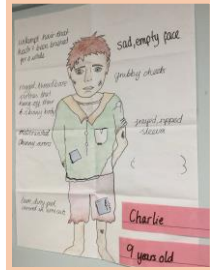
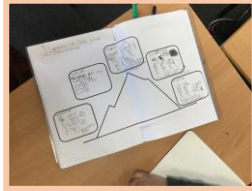
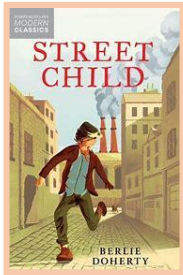

Every child followed the Alice modelling what and how much of each ingredient they needed to add into the mixing bowl. This required them to use their mathematics knowledge of mass and capacity to make sure the measurements were all accurate for each ingredient! Once all the ingredients had been put into the bowl, then they used their hands to mix and knead the dough together. Have a look at some of the skills being practiced!
