What you can expect:

Computing (Years 1,2&3):

This is a club continuing from autumn term but we welcome new comers as well. Children will focus on basic computing skills but start to use programming and hardware.

Mini-Movers (Years 1,2&3):

Children will play a variety of games to get them enthused about keeping healthy and enjoying team activities.

Science club (Years 1,2&3):

Children will have the opportunity to conduct mini experiements and learn more about the world we live in.

Design club (Years 1,2&3):

Teaching technical aspects of design, children will improve their fine motor skills and use their creativity when designing.

Home Learning club (Year 1 -6):

This club aims to provide a peaceful learning environment for completing home-learning. This club is particularly designed for children who may not have the right environment at home to concentrate on their learning rather than if a child requires lots of support.

Football (Years 4 & 5):

Open to girls and boys, football club will develop your skills, use of space, positioning...and who knows, you could be playing for a football club one day! This club aims to be fun for all abilities and will teach children the social and health benefits of playing football.

Design Club (Year 4 & 5):

Children will work towards creating faux stained glass windows using a variety of design and art techniques.

Racket Sports (Years 4 & 5):

Focussing first on badminton and then tennis, children will learn the key techniques and develop their hand-eye coordination in games.

Piano club (Year 4 & 5):

We welcome back children who have enjoyed piano club in the autumn term but this will also be suitable for new joiners.

Film Critics club (Year 4,5 & 6)):

This club will be a lot more than just watching films. Children will learn how to discuss aspects of film, debate the effectiveness and write reviews.

Learning Minds (Years 1,2, & 3):

Learning Minds is small group learning that happens after-school. You cannot sign up for this; selected children will receive a notification through Parent Hub if they have been identified for this support.

Young Tower Hamlets Youth centre (Year 6 only):

Pupils in Year 6 can access the Youth centre in PAL space from 3:30pm onwards. This is not run by Bigland Green school and parents will need to register their child at their first session.

Parents will be invited in to after-school clubs on the week beginning Monday 24 March where children will showcase the learning they have been doing.
